

## IOWA LOTTERY GAME SPECIFIC RULES

The following are the game specific rules for the Iowa Lottery computerized game called Iowa’s \$100,000 Cash Game.

These rules correspond to the Computerized Lottery Games General Rules in the Iowa Administrative Code Section 531 Chapter 20.

531-20.3 (99G) Method of play. To play Iowa’s \$100,000 Cash Game, a player must select one or more sets of five different two-digit numbers from 01 through 35. A drawing is held daily Monday through Saturday in which five numbers are drawn. A player may select each game play by communicating the five numbers to a retailer or by requesting “easy pick” from a retailer. A player may also mark five numbered squares or the “easy pick” square in any one game panel on a play slip and submit the play slip to a retailer. The retailer will then issue a ticket, via a terminal, containing the selected set or sets of numbers.

531-20.4 (99G) Cancellation by a player. A ticket purchased from a retailer may be canceled by returning the ticket to the selling retailer. The ticket must be returned to the selling retailer on the same day it was purchased. The ticket must be canceled prior to the time for that respective drawing. In the event that a ticket is canceled, the player will be entitled to a refund equal to the purchase price of the ticket.

531-20.5 (99G) Prizes and odds. The prizes awarded shall be as follows:

<u>Number of Matches</u>	<u>Odds</u>	<u>Prize Amount</u>
Five Winning Numbers	1 in 324,632	\$100,000.00 (\$300,000 maximum per drawing)
Four Winning Numbers	1 in 2,164	\$100.00
Three Winning Numbers	1 in 75	\$5.00
Two Winning Numbers	1 in 8	Free Play

The maximum amount paid to all winners matching five winning numbers shall be \$300,000.00. If more than three plays have all five winning numbers, the \$300,000.00 shall be split equally among the uncanceled plays with the winning numbers.

The lottery may transfer 50 percent of sales less awarded prizes to a prize insurance fund. The prize insurance fund may be used to pay prizes if the amount available to fund any \$100,000 Cash Game prize is insufficient, for special promotions related to any lottery game, for prizes in any lottery game if the amount available is not sufficient to pay a minimum or guaranteed prize. These prize funds may be transferred as proceeds provided that the overall lottery prize payout is in excess of 50 percent of sales.

531-20.9 (99G) Price. A game play in Iowa’s \$100,000 Cash Game shall sell for \$1.00 including sales tax.

531-20.12 (99G) Ticket validation requirements. All standard test for validation must be met including but not limited to confidential G-guard specifications.

531-20.13 (99G) Claim period. All prizes must be claimed as directed within 90 calendar days of the drawing in which the prize was won. For purposes of determining the claim period, the first (draw) day shall be excluded, and the last included. In the event the last day falls on a Saturday, a Sunday, a legal Holiday or any day appointed or recommended by the Governor of Iowa or the President of the United States as a day of fasting or thanksgiving, the time to claim shall be extended to close of business on the next day thereafter when lottery offices are open for business. Any prize not claimed within the specified period shall be forfeited.

531-20.19 (99G) Multidraw plays and advance plays. Multidraw plays and advance plays are available. The combination of advanced plays and multidraw plays may not exceed 24 drawings.

531-20.20 (99G) Drawings Six drawings shall be held each week. Drawings will be held each day Monday through Saturday. Tickets are valid for only the draw date(s) shown on the tickets.

The drawing will be held in accordance with the schedule posted to the Lottery's Web site ([www.ialottery.com](http://www.ialottery.com)) under the heading "Public Drawings." The drawings will be held on the specified date under the supervision of the Drawings Officer, an independent auditor and a lottery security officer. All drawings are videotaped. All drawings of the Iowa Lottery Authority are public events.

Persons who attend drawings must show a valid photo ID and be supervised by a member of the Iowa Lottery Security Division during the drawing. A request to attend a drawing must be received by the lottery no later than 10:00 a.m. on the morning of the drawing.
