

Open Records Information Provided By The Iowa Lottery In March 2019

(On average, responses were provided within 8 calendar days.)

On March 4, NuPoint Funding LLC of Boca Raton, Fla., requested a list of annuity winners for February 2019. In addition, the company requested any court orders for February 2019. On March 11, the Iowa Lottery provided one email with the requested information. There was no charge for this request.

On March 4, Lisa Sawyer requested details about any lottery wins by Donna Shea from 2001 to 2019. On March 19, the Iowa Lottery provided one email with the requested information. There was no charge for this request.

On March 7, IGT Printing of Lakeland, Fla., requested copies of the Iowa Lottery's ticket-printing contracts with Scientific Games International in Alpharetta, Ga., and Pollard Banknote Ltd. in Winnipeg, Canada. On March 12, the Iowa Lottery provided one email with the requested information contained in two attachments. There was no charge for this request.

On March 25, Deltek in Seattle, Wash., requested a list of all current Iowa Lottery contracts bid out on an annual basis, including a description of each contract, its expiration date, awarded vendor name, and other details including renewal terms and pricing information. On April 3, the Iowa Lottery provided one email with the information contained in an attachment. There was no charge for this request.

On March 27, the University of Chicago in Chicago, Ill., requested a list of Iowa Lottery winners' information for all prizes of more than \$600, including corresponding information for the retail location where the winning ticket was purchased, for as many years' worth of data as the lottery had available. On April 18, the Iowa Lottery provided one email with the information contained in an attachment, noting that it did not have all of the requested information for each winner. There was no charge for this request.
