

Open Records Information Provided By The Iowa Lottery In May 2019

(On average, responses were provided within 11 calendar days.)

On May 1, NuPoint Funding LLC of Boca Raton, Fla., requested a list of annuity winners and any new or updated court orders for April 2019 to present. The next day, the Iowa Lottery provided one email with the requested information. There was no charge for this request.

On May 6, Michael Conallen of Yardley, Pa., requested a copy of an RFP issued by the Iowa Lottery and awarded to Scientific Games in March 2017. In an email on May 22, the Iowa Lottery clarified that while there had been discussion at the Iowa Lottery Board's March 2017 meeting about sales-force automation capabilities, the agreement between the Iowa Lottery and Scientific Games that resulted from that discussion was signed in September 2018. Additionally, the lottery clarified that while Sci-Games had received an extension of its Iowa online gaming system contract through an agreement signed in January 2017, that agreement tied back to the lottery's 2010 online gaming system RFP. Along with its email, the lottery provided two attachments that contained the September 2018 agreement and the June 2010 online gaming system RFP. There was no charge for this request.

On May 20, IGT Printing of Lakeland, Fla., requested copies of the RFP bid documents submitted by Scientific Games International of Alpharetta, Ga., and Pollard Banknote Ltd. of Winnipeg, Canada, in response to Iowa Lottery RFP IL-18-04 for scratch-ticket printing. On June 10, the Iowa Lottery provided the requested documentation. There was no charge for this request.

On May 22, Montana State University in Bozeman, Mont., requested weekly Powerball and Mega Millions sales in Iowa by retail location from Jan. 1, 2011, through the present. On May 30, the Iowa Lottery provided the requested information by sharing a file on Google Drive. There was no charge for this request.

On May 24, Pollard Banknote Ltd. of Winnipeg, Canada, requested the preliminary/final notice of contract award status for Iowa Lottery RFP IL-18-04 for scratch-ticket printing. In addition, Pollard requested the corresponding evaluation information for all vendors that responded to the RFP; and the redacted technical proposals from those same vendors. On June 10, the Iowa Lottery provided the requested documentation. There was no charge for this request.
