

Jingle Bills Promotion Rules

The Jingle Bills promotion is an Iowa Lottery VIP Club web-based Play It Again[®] promotion offering sixty-four (64) \$1,000 cash prizes and a \$20,000 Grand Prize with drawings every two weeks. The entry period for this promotion, which can be entered by members of the VIP Club with eligible nonwinning holiday scratch tickets, begins at noon Central Time (CT) on Tuesday, October 11, 2016. Each entry period will begin at noon and end two weeks later at 11:59:59 a.m. The number of \$1,000 cash prizes available increases every two weeks during the promotion. The web cache mechanism empties after the 11:59:59 a.m. entry deadline and starts with zero entries at noon with each Tuesday two-week entry period. Entries submitted for each of the seven drawings that are not selected as a winner of a \$1,000 prize are eligible for the \$20,000 Grand Prize drawing. The promotion ends at 11:59:59 a.m. Tuesday, January 17, 2017.

*All entries submitted during the Jingle Bills promotion that were not selected as a winner in a previous Jingle Bills drawing will be eligible for a chance at one \$20,000 Grand Prize.

The Jingle Bills promotion prizes are subject to lottery statues, rules, validation procedures, off-sets and deductions authorized by law. The Iowa Lottery will withhold all state and federal taxes as may be required by law. Winners are responsible for all other taxes that may be due and owing.

Entry

Entrants must join or be a current member of the Iowa Lottery VIP Club. Entry into the promotion is accomplished by legally acquiring and entering an eligible Iowa Lottery holiday scratch ticket in accordance with these rules:

\$1 Games: #309 White Elephant, #318 Holiday Cheer

\$2 Games: #310 Moosletoe Doubler, #311 Holiday Season Bingo, #319 Holiday Sparkle

\$3 Games: #312 Naughty or Nice, #313 Holiday Surprise Crossword

\$5 Games: #314 Ho Ho Ho Tripler #315 \$50,000 Holiday Super Crossword

\$10 Games: #316 Money Tree, #317 \$100,000 Holiday Mega Crossword

The \$1 Holiday Cheer and \$2 Moosletoe Doubler will go on sale October 31, 2016.

If the ticket is an eligible, nonwinning ticket, players can visit the Iowa Lottery website at ialottery.com to enter the Jingle Bills promotion with the entry number (located on the front of the ticket) and the ticket number (located on the back of the ticket above the bar code).

Players may enter multiple tickets, but an eligible scratch ticket can be entered only once. While a VIP Club member can enter multiple times in each drawing, each person may win only one prize in a drawing. The web cache mechanism empties after the entry deadline and starts with zero entries at the beginning of the drawing entry period, except for the Grand Prize drawing. All entries submitted during the Jingle Bills promotion that were not selected as a winner for a previous Jingle Bills drawing are eligible for the \$20,000 Grand Prize drawing. A player could win a \$1,000 prize in each of the seven drawings that he or she entered as well as the \$20,000 grand prize. Winning holiday scratch tickets are not eligible for entry into this promotion. Entrants must follow the VIP Club rules. Entry into the Jingle Bills promotion is sufficient for presentation of a ticket for validation purposes for this promotion. Players do not need to keep their tickets after entering them.

Eligibility

An eligible entry is any legally acquired nonwinning ticket in any of the following Iowa Lottery scratch games: \$1 Game #309 White Elephant, \$1 Game #318 Holiday Cheer, \$2 Game #310 Moosletoe Doubler, \$2 Game #311 Holiday Season Bingo, \$2 Game #319 Holiday Sparkle, \$3 Game #312 Naughty or Nice, \$3 Game #313 Holiday Surprise Crossword, \$5 Game #314 Ho Ho Ho Tripler, \$5 Game #315 \$50,000 Holiday Super Crossword, \$10 Game #316 Money Tree or \$10 Game #317 \$100,000 Holiday Mega Crossword that have not been previously submitted as an entry in this promotion on the Lottery website. Except as provided under the "CEO's Discretion" herein below, an eligible entry is one in which the web entry information is completed and submitted electronically during the posted entry time as specified on the Iowa Lottery website. A nonwinning eligible scratch ticket may be entered only once. Players may attempt to enter or submit up to 40 total entries per day in their VIP Club account. Each attempt of ticket submission counts as one entry attempt. All entrants must be 21 years of age or older. A person could win one prize in each drawing in the Jingle Bills promotion that he or she has entered.

Players who have signed up for the Iowa Lottery self-exclusion program are not eligible to participate in this promotion. Members of the Iowa Lottery Authority Board of Directors and Iowa Lottery Authority employees and their immediate families, as defined by statute, are not eligible. Further, officers, employees, agents, or subcontractors of any vendor who have access to confidential information that may compromise the integrity of the Lottery, and their immediate families as defined by statute, are not eligible.

Drawings

The drawings will be held in accordance with the schedule posted to the Lottery's website (ialottery.com) and listed in the rules. The Jingle Bills promotion drawings will be held under the supervision of an independent auditor. All drawings of the Iowa Lottery Authority are public events. Persons interested in attending drawings are invited to receive detailed information by contacting the Iowa Lottery Security Division at 515-725-7900, TTY Relay Iowa at 800-735-2942, or by email directed to WMaster@ialottery.com. Persons who attend drawings must show a valid government-issued photo identification and be supervised by a member of the Iowa Lottery Security Division during the drawing. A request to attend a drawing must be received by the Lottery no later than 48 hours in advance of the drawing. All drawings are recorded.

The winners' names will be posted on the Lottery's website by the end of the day following the draw day or as soon as available. Each selected winner will be sent an email to his or her VIP Club member address. Entrants are not required to personally attend the drawing or be present at the time of the drawing to be determined a winner. Each of the selected numbers will be verified against the numbers entered in the promotion. A sufficient number of entries will be randomly selected to ensure there are valid winners for the prizes to be announced. If the number drawn is determined to be ineligible for any reason or the winner of a Jingle Bills prize doesn't present a fully executed claim form and required documentation by 4:00 p.m. Wednesday, February 1, 2017 to claim the prize, the cash prize will go back into the prize pool.

The prize winners in the Jingle Bills promotion drawings must complete and sign a winner claim form along with appropriate documentation and present those documents with a legible copy of their government-issued photo identification to the Iowa Lottery by 4:00 p.m. CT on Wednesday, February 1, 2017 to claim their prize. The prize will be subject to tax in the year in which it was claimed. Winners will receive a W2-G tax withholding form for the calendar year in which the prize was claimed.

By submitting an entry into the Jingle Bills promotion and claiming the prize, the entrant certifies he or she is the sole owner of the entry, the entrant is at least 21 years old, the ticket is not stolen, and the entrant is not disqualified from receiving a prize. By entering the promotion, the entrant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the State of Iowa and the Iowa Lottery Authority, its elected officials, apprentices, employees, agents and volunteers. In consideration for participating in the promotion, the entrant waives any and all claims the entrant may have or ever claim to have against the State of Iowa, the Iowa Lottery, its employees, agents, or board members, relating in any way to the promotion. The player also consents to the use by the Lottery of his or her name and/or likeness for advertising, trade or promotional purposes without further compensation.

Odds

The odds of winning a Jingle Bills promotion prize will vary depending on the number of entries.

Iowa Lottery Authority CEO's Discretion

If the CEO, or the CEO's designee, determines that an otherwise valid entry has been foiled by any human or technical error, whether by a Lottery employee, Lottery retailer or Lottery vendor, the CEO may authorize the replacement of an eligible entry or a refund of the ticket price. This shall be the player's only recourse against the Lottery or its personnel.

Force Majeure

If the Iowa Lottery Authority is hindered from providing the prizes due to riots, acts of God, shortages of labor or materials, war, acts of terrorism, governmental laws, regulations or restrictions or any other causes of any kind whatsoever which are beyond the reasonable control of the Iowa Lottery Authority, the Iowa Lottery Authority shall not be liable or responsible for its inability to provide some or all of the prizes discussed herein.

Choice of Law and Forum

If disputes arise beyond those covered by incidents referenced in the CEO's discretion section, the laws of the State of Iowa shall govern and determine all matters arising out of or in connection with this promotion. Any and all litigation commenced in connection with this promotion shall be brought and maintained solely in Polk County District Court of the State of Iowa, Des Moines Iowa, or in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Iowa, Central Division, Des Moines, Iowa, wherever jurisdiction is appropriate. This provision shall not be construed as waiving any immunity in state or federal court, which may be available to the Lottery or the State of Iowa.

Disclaimer

The Iowa Lottery, the State of Iowa, and their employees, officers, directors, and agents shall not be responsible for and shall not be liable for:

- Otherwise eligible entries that are entered inaccurately, incorrectly, or arrive after the entry deadline;
- Any damage to an entrant's computer system that is directly or indirectly caused by accessing or downloading content from ialottery.com, ialotteryvip.com or otherwise participating in this promotion; or
- Any computer system, phone line, hardware, software or program malfunctions; or
- Other errors, failures, dropped or delayed computer transmissions or network connections that are human or technical in nature.

Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Iowa Lottery is not responsible for incomplete, illegible, misdirected, late, lost damaged or stolen entries; or for lost, interrupted, inaccessible or unavailable networks, satellites, Internet Service Providers (ISP), website or other connections; or for miscommunications; failed, jumbled, scrambled, delayed, or misdirected computer, telephone or cable transmission; or for any technical malfunctions, failures or difficulties; printing errors; clerical, typographical or other error in the offering or announcement of any prize or in any prize notification documents, or other errors of any kind or nature; or for the incorrect or inaccurate capture of information or the failure to capture information, whether or not such issues are alleged to have been caused in whole or in part by the action or omission of the Lottery, its employees, or agents.

Caution: Any attempt by anyone to deliberately damage the website or undermine the legitimate operation of the promotion may be in violation of criminal and civil laws and will result in disqualification if the individual is an entrant. If such an attempt is made, the Iowa Lottery reserves the right to seek remedies and damages (including attorney's fees) from any such person to the fullest extent of the law, including criminal prosecution. The Iowa Lottery, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to cancel the promotion if the system through which the promotion is operated has become technically corrupted or if the integrity of the promotion has in any way been comprised.
